Instructional Focus:

Reading

Students read a variety of grade level materials, applying strategies appropriate to various situations.

Writing

Students write for a variety of purposes and audiences with sophistication and complexity appropriate to the grade level.

Listening

Students listen for a variety of purposes appropriate to the grade level.

Performance Task

Using Microsoft PowerPoint or ClarisWorks, students will create a presentation to demonstrate their knowledge of the book's plot, theme, and traits of the main characters. The presentation must be of a length appropriate to student grade level and the reading level of the book (approximately 10 to 20 slides). Each slide must have a picture from clip art or the Internet that accurately portrays the plot, theme, or trait of a main character. This work may be done independently or in groups.
