### Instructional Focus:

#### Listening –

Students listen for a variety of purposes appropriate to the grade level.

#### Speaking –

Students speak for a variety of purposes and audiences with sophistication and complexity appropriate to the grade level.

#### Reading –

Students read a variety of grade level materials, applying strategies appropriate to various situations.

### Performance Task

1. This lesson will orient students to the school and the people who work there.
2. Prior to this activity, alert school staff to the scavenger hunt day and time. The staff should be prepared to tell students their job duties and to answer questions.
3. Write the entries from the handout (see School Scavenger Hunt Chart) provided on separate cards.
4. Divide the class into groups of 3-4, giving each group an equal number of cards.
5. Give each group 20 minutes to “find” their answers, obtain signatures and return to the class. You may wish to have an adult accompany each group.
6. Have the groups report back on their results and experiences.

Each entry below is written on an individual card.

1. Find a person in the school whose job it is to answer the telephone and take messages.  
Possible answers: elementary secretary, high school secretary, Superintendent's secretary
2. Find a person in the school who pays the bills for the school.  
Possible answers: business manager, assistant business manager
3. Find a person in the school who types letters for the school.  
Possible answers: elementary secretary, high school secretary, Superintendent's secretary
4. Find a person in the school who helps prepare the meals.  
Possible answers: cooks
5. Find a person in the school who plans the meals.  
Possible answers: head cook, dietician
6. Find a person in the school who teaches wellness to the students.  
Possible answers: P.E./health teacher, school nurse
7. Find a person in the school who teaches phonics to primary grade students.  
Possible answers: Kindergarten teacher, grade 1 - 3 teachers
8. Find a person in the school who is in charge of recess duty.  
Possible answers: teacher aide, elementary teacher, assistant teacher, elementary principal
9. Find a person in the school who helps students in the lunchroom.  
Possible answers: teacher aide, elementary teacher assistant, teacher
10. Find a person in the school who washes and waxes the floors.  
Possible answers: custodian, janitor, head of maintenance
11. Find a person in the school who drives students to school on a bus  
Possible answers: bus driver, substitute bus driver, transportation manager
12. Find a person in the school who plans the bus routes.  
Possible answers: transportation manager, Superintendent
13. Find a person in the school who is in charge of reporting school activities to the school board.  
Possible answers: Superintendent, Principals
14. Find a person in the school who is responsible for supervising school discipline.  
Possible answers: Principals
15. Find a person in the school who teaches geography to students.  
Possible answers: elementary teachers, social studies teacher

16. Find someone in the school who helps students learn about careers.  
Possible answers: counselor, classroom teachers, School-to-Work Coordinator
17. Find someone in the school who teaches math.  
Possible answers: elementary classroom teachers, math teachers
18. Find someone in the school who teaches a foreign language (name the language)  
Possible answers: Spanish teacher, German teacher, etc.
19. Find a person in the school who is in charge of scheduling students' classes.  
Possible answers: counselor, high school and middle school principals
20. Find a person in the school whose job it is to listen to students' problems and help them try to work them out.  
Possible answers: Counselor
21. Find a person in the school whose job it is to help students with learning disabilities?  
Possible answers: LD teacher, resource room teacher
22. Find a person in the school whose job it is to spend extra time each day with students who need more help in subjects such as reading or math.  
Possible answers: Title One teacher, LD teacher, resource room teacher
23. Find a person in the school who is in charge of fixing things.  
Possible answers: Head of maintenance, janitor, custodians
24. Find a person in the school who teaches music to the students.  
Possible answers: Elementary music teacher, vocal instructor, middle school and high school music teacher, band teacher
25. Find a person in the school who takes students out of the room individually or in small groups to work on speech.  
Possible answers: speech pathologist, speech clinician
26. Find a person in the school who is in charge of the testing.  
Possible answers: Counselor, school psychologist
