Instructional Focus:

Listening – Students listen for a variety of purposes appropriate to the grade level.

Speaking – Students speak for a variety of purposes and audiences with sophistication and complexity appropriate to the grade level.

Reading – Students read a variety of grade level materials, applying strategies appropriate to various situations.

Performance Task

1. Students will read aloud or listen to the story, The Berenstain Bears and the Messy Room, Sam and Jan Berenstain. (A similar story may be used.)
2. Discuss with the students the “work” involved in changing the messy room to a clean room.
3. Ask the students to name the benefits of having a clean room.
4. Ask them to list the feelings that they would associate with those benefits.
5. In closing, ask students what they enjoy about school. Is school work?
6. Ask the students to help you make a bulletin board for the classroom entitled “Fun at Work”. Ask students to draw a picture of themselves doing a work activity either at home or at school.
